In her 20 years creating career, her works not only displayed in Amsterdam from Netherlands, Basel from Switzerland, Madrid from Spain, Cologne from Germany, New Delhi from India, New York from America etc, but also gain countless awards, she is the first female artist granted the highest award form Rudana Museum in Indonesia.

International media used to introduce her works as "Hot Famed™". This is not only her fame and influence in art field, but more compliments for her sculpture series works that using the chillies to be the source material. When she use the red hot "chilli™" pulling up on the green plants, the vision slug build by spicy posture, as if millions of flags lifting and waving, it can help but letting people feel the life is burning and the summon when the life boils.

Kumari was born in India, used to learn and grow in University of arts London. When she is talking to why she regards chilli as her item of her art, she answered that her life was came from India, so her notion was completely covered by Indian philosophy. In Indian classical philosophy, chilli presents as the sharp weapon against negative. As the Chinese saying that it can avoid evil influence. The seed of chilli is very colorful and plump, though the size is small, it has powerful life and it has the potential and dream to be a huge tree. " She has the beauty and vitality you appreciated, as my sculpture series "chilli™", chillies are dancing Tango expressively; or another group sculpture series "happiness swing™", the mood of the chilli is flying in the air But chilli is not meek and

simple, when chili stands in front of the evils who think they are superior to anyone else, the back face of the beautiful chili may hide the power and dignity you can't nose out, her incisive and piercingly cold may stop the arrogant and conceited, overbearing and sinister, because when chili appears, her richness odor will let the sinister escape in a horror.

So we are looking forward to Shanghai Art Fair 2011 14th - 18th Sept at ShanghaiMART, "Tango" not only dance with art, but also with art collectors, let the art exhibition panic wave higher and higher.
